

Prepare for Healing

Feed your Faith

Each believer is given a measure of faith. To grow your faith, you must nourish it daily (Romans 12:3).

Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God (Hebrews 11:1). To receive from God, you must first believe you receive. But how can you receive that which you do not know? The word of God says, "The Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on the Word day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous" (Joshua 1:8). Are you feeding your Faith? Reading, and hearing the Word of God everyday keeps your soul prosperous, like eating a healthy diet keeps your body healthy. It's time to gain wisdom on what the scriptures say about healing and begin building your faith for healing.

So, "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospers" (3 John 2).

Below are scriptures about Jesus Healing Ministry and the many ways He went about "doing good." Meditate on these scriptures to prepare yourself for healing. Meditate on, read aloud and put to memory the scriptures you need (you can search the bible via search engine for more healing scriptures). Write them on index cards, place them around your home, take them to work, put them in your car.

First before you pray, if you have any ought against your brother, first forgive your brother, so that God can hear your prayers. **Mark 11:25** "And when you stand praying if you hold anything against anyone, forgive them, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins." So, take some time right now to ask the Lord to forgive you for any resentment or grudge against your neighbor, forgive anyone you may have ought against, then proceed by reading, praying, and meditating on the scriptures below.

According to your own faith

Mark 5:34, “He said to her, Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering.”

Luke 17:19, “Then he said to him, “Rise and go, your faith has made you well.”

Luke 18:42, “Jesus said to him, “receive your sight, your faith has healed you.”

Luke 7:50, “And he said to the woman, “Your faith has saved you; go in peace.”

Matthew 9:28, “Then he touched their eyes and said, “According to your faith let it be done to you.” (Do you believe Jesus heals today, do you believe He can heal you?)

Healed with a Command

Psalms 107:20, “He sent out His Word and healed them; he rescued them from the grave.”

Jesus is the Word. He rescues man from eternal death. Salvation is the greatest healing of all. Have you received the greatest healing of all? The Word of God says, “that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation” (Romans 10:9).

Matthew 8:16, “When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a Word and healed all the sick.”

Faith must be fed. **Romans 10:17**, “**Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God.**” Are you feeding your faith?

Prayer offered in Faith by the Elders

James 5:14, “Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elder of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord.”

James 5:15, “And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven.”

Jesus saliva

John 9:6, “When He had said these things, He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva; and He anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay. And He said to him, “Go, wash in the pool of Siloam.” So, he went and washed and came back seeing”

Garments

Acts 19:12 “So that even handkerchiefs and aprons that had touched him were taken to the sick, and their illnesses were cured, and the evil spirits left them.”

Matthew 9:21 “She said to herself, If I only touch his cloak, I will be healed.” (her faith and Jesus power meet up).

Acts 5:15 “As a result, people brought the sick in to the streets and laid them on beds and mats so that at least Peter’s shadow might fall on some of them as he passed by.”

Healed through obedience to a command

2 Kings 5:10, “Elisha sent a messenger to say to him, “Go, wash yourself seven times in the Jordan, and your flesh will be restored, and you will be cleansed.”

Heals through touch

Mark 5:27-30, “When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment. For she said, “If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well.” Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed of the affliction. And

Jesus, immediately knowing in Himself that power had gone out of Him, turned around in the crowd and said, "Who touched My clothes?"

Matthew 8:1-3, "When He had come down from the mountain, great multitudes followed Him. And behold, a leper came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, you can make me clean." Then Jesus put out His hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." Immediately his leprosy was cleansed."

Mark 6:5, "He could not do any miracles there, except lay his hands on a few sick people and heal them."

Luke 4:40, "While the sun was setting, all those who had any who were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and laying His hands on each one of them, He was healing them."

Jesus Heals many afflictions

Matthew 9:35, "Jesus was going through all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness."

Mark 7:37, "They were utterly astonished, saying, "He has done all things well; He makes even the deaf to hear and the mute to speak."

Jesus Healed

Isaiah 53:5, "But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed."

Matthew 8:8, "But the centurion said, "Lord, I am not worthy for You to come under my roof, but just say the word, and my servant will be healed."

Luke 6:19, "And all the people were trying to touch Him, for power was coming from Him and healing them all."
